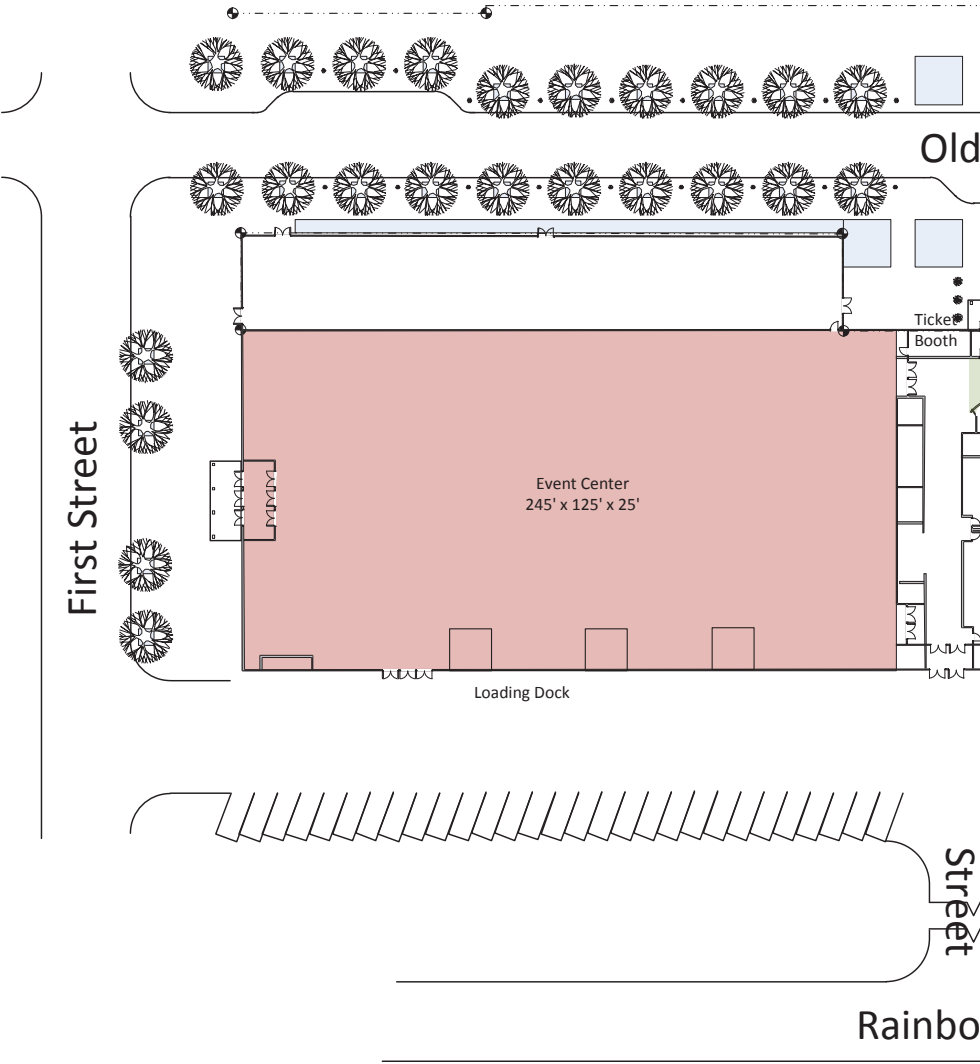

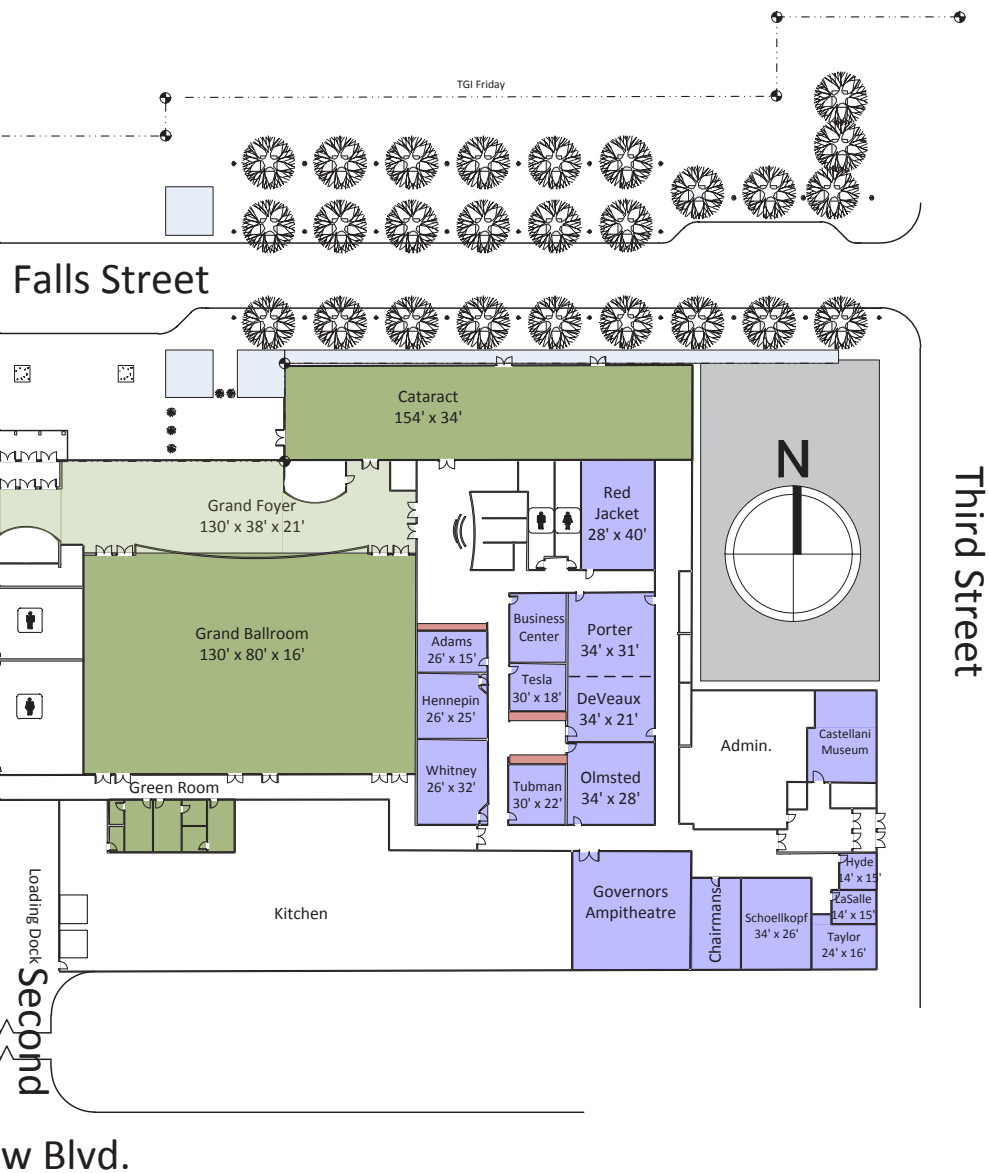

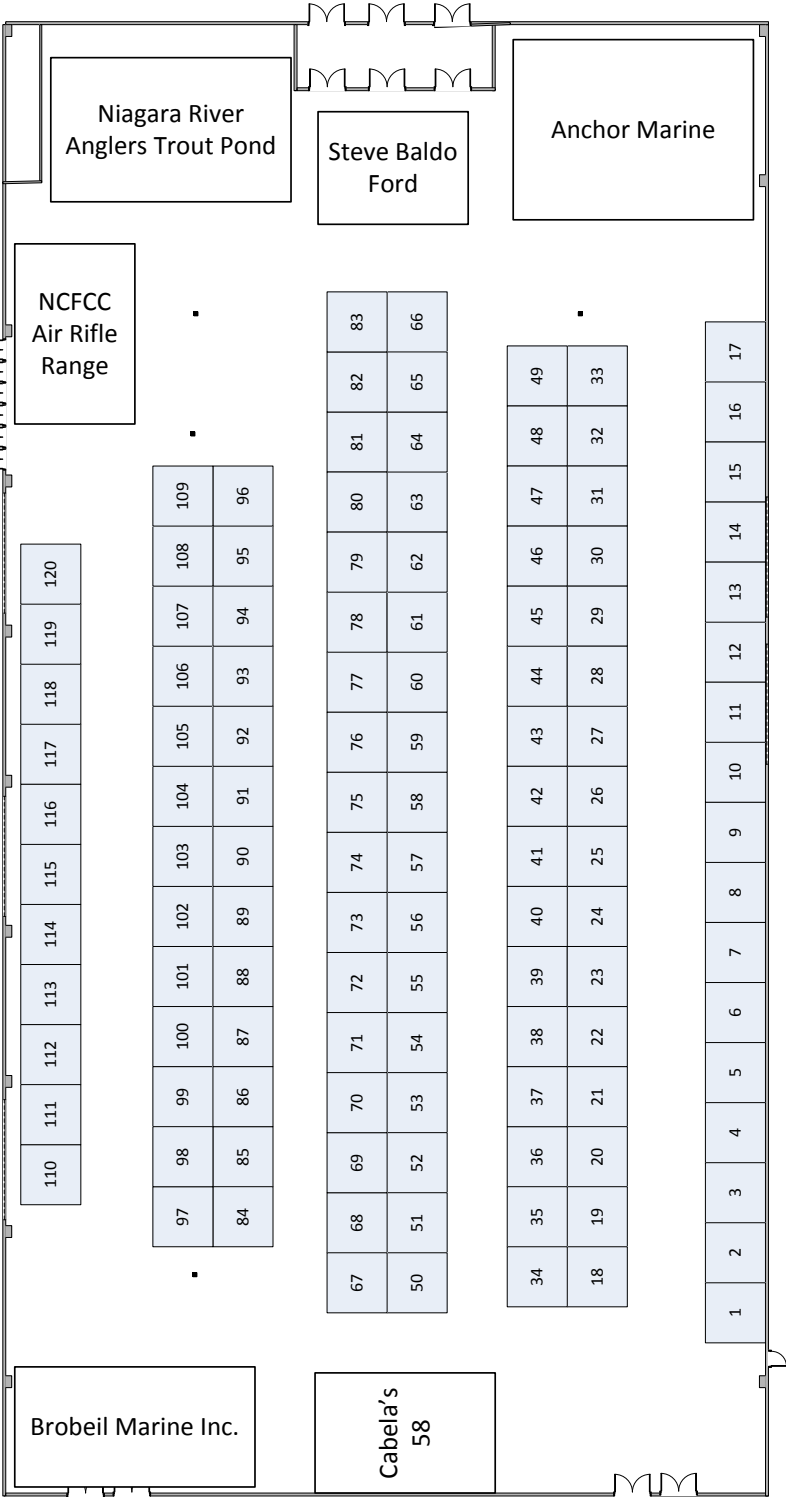

EVENT CENTER EXHIBITOR MAP



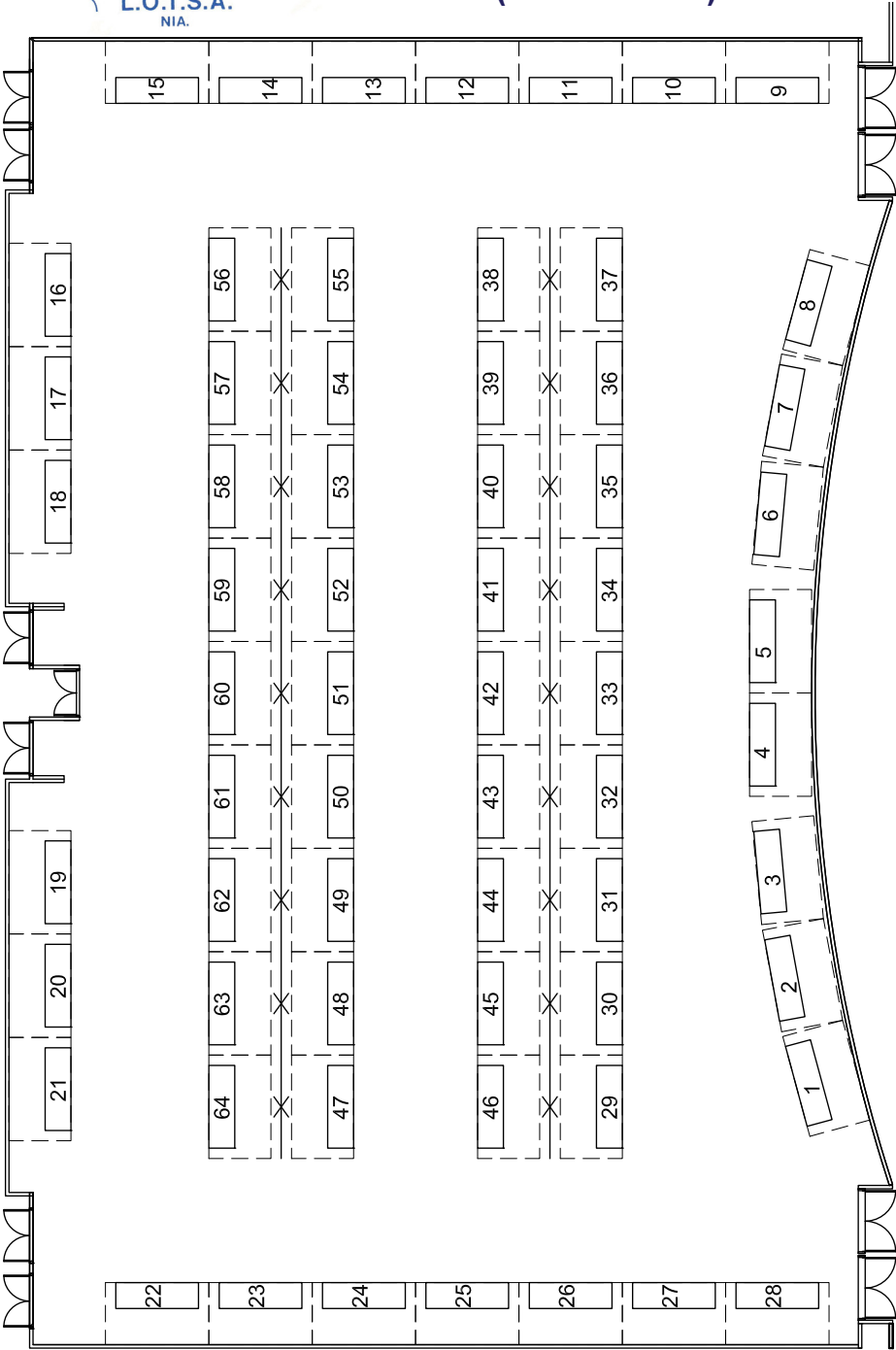
